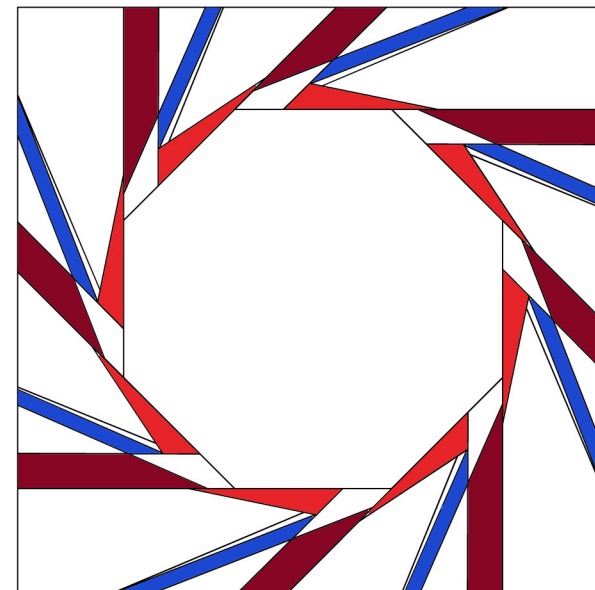
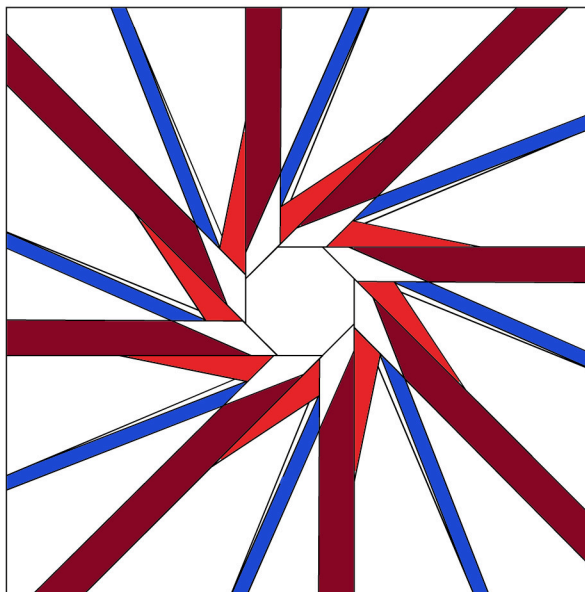
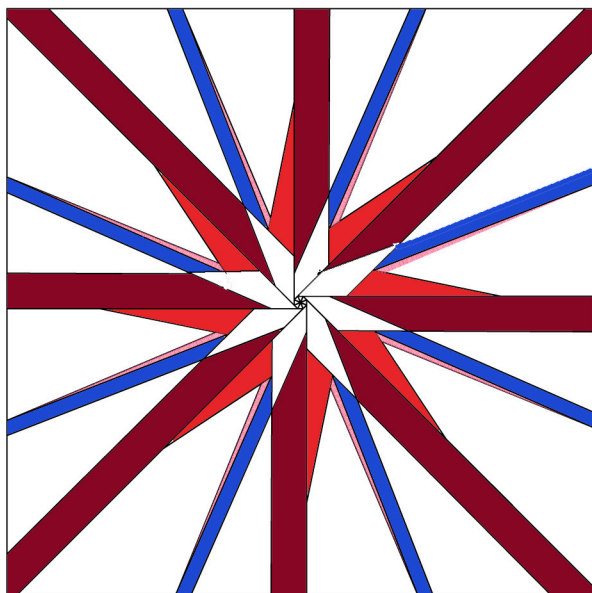
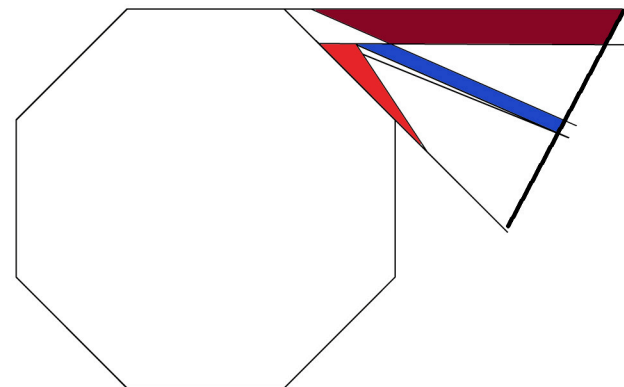
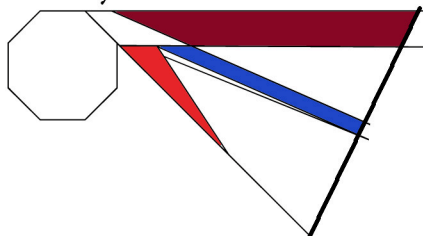
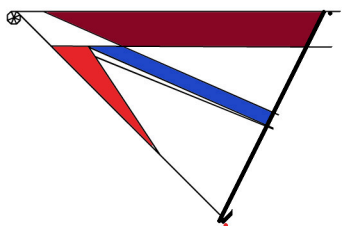


*You can split a 45 degree wedge into any sort of rays for other interesting outcomes.
